

Stage 3

Range B – Porky’s Cantina

“Tequila, We Don’t Drink No Stinkin’ Tequila.”

Ammunition: 10 Pistol, 18 Rifle, 4 Shotgun

Pistol, loaded, 5 each, holstered.

Rifles, loaded, 9 each, staged at corral door.

Shotguns, O/E, staged at corral door.

What a night, drinkin’ To-Kill-Ya all night long. Just as the sun comes up, now you will have to pay for stealin’ those kisses. Standing in the doorway of Porky’s, at the sound of the buzzer the first shooter draws his first pistol and engages pistol targets, P-1 through P-5. Re-holster, as the second shooter picks up his rifle at the corral doorway and Nevada sweeps the rifle targets. Restage your rifle, as the first shooter moves to the corral doorway the second shooter moves inside of Porky’s. The first shooter picks up his rifle and starting at R-5, Nevada sweeps the rifle targets. Restage your rifle, as the second shooter draws his pistol and engages pistol targets in any order. Re-holster your pistol and move to the corral doorway. Both shooters pick up their staged O/E shotguns and starting with the first shooter, alternating, engage four shotgun swingers in any order. Stage is complete, go to unloading table.

Stage 4

Range B – Gun Store

“Let’s Try Em All.”

Ammunition: 20 Pistol, 20 Rifle, 8 shotgun

Pistols, loaded, 5 each, staged on table.

Rifles, loaded, 10 each, staged on table.

Shotguns, O/E, staged on table.

You are at the grand opening of the new Gun Shop in town. What a delight. All these toys and the owner is going to let you play with all of them. At the sound of the buzzer, the first shooter picks up his first pistol and engages pistol targets in any order. Place the pistol back on the table, take your second pistol and engage pistol targets in any order again. Place pistol back on table. Pick up your rifle and double tap rifle targets in any order. Place rifle pack on table. Pick up shotgun and engage any four shotgun swingers, any order. Second shooter, repeat what first shooter just did. Stage is complete, go to the unloading table.

Stage 5

Range C – Prairie Settlement

“Cookin’, Cleanin’ and Bakin’”

Ammunition: 10 Pistol, 18 Rifle, 3 Shotgun

Pistol, load 5 each, holstered

Rifle, loaded 9, staged at water well.

Shotgun, O/E, staged at Outhouse.

Ok, time to do some long needed cleaning up of this place, also to do a little bakin’ and then cook a nice meal. But first, that morning constitutional is calling you. Starting at the Outhouse, at the buzzer the first shooter draws his first pistol and engage all five (5) pistol targets in any order. Re-holster that pistol. The second shooter hearing all that shooting, looks out the prairie house door and drawing his first pistol engages all five pistol targets in any order. The first shooter, steps out of the outhouse, picks up his rifle and Nevada sweeps the rifle targets. Restage that rifle, as the second shooter picks up his his rifle but he must wait until the first shooter goes back inside the outhouse. The second shooters Nevada sweeps the rifle targets. When the second shooter is done sweeping the rifle targets the first shooter exits the outside to the left and engages any three shotgun swingers. Stage is complete, go to the unloading table.

Note: Timer stays with the first shooter.

Stage 2

Range A – Main Street

“Jail Watch & Saloon Detail”

Ammunition: 20 Pistol, 20 Rifle, 8 shotgun

Pistols, loaded, 5 each, holstered.

Rifles, loaded, 10 each, staged at back of jail, saloon bar.

Shotguns, O/E, staged back of jail, saloon bar.

What a day. You just lost the coin toss and now you are stuck watching that no good, chicken stealin’, stinky smellin’ town drunk, until the sheriff gets back, while your buddy is down at the saloon have drinks and flirtin’ with those soiled doves. At the sound of the buzzer, the first shooter draws his 1st pistol and engages pistol targets to his right, P-1 through P-5. Re-holsters first pistol and draws second pistol and engages same targets P-5 through P-1. Second shooters, hearing all that racket, picks up his rifle from the saloon bar top and double taps rifle targets in any order. First shooters picks up his rifle staged in the jail rack and sweeps rifle targets in any order twice. Restage rifles as the second shooters draws his 1st pistol and engages pistol targets to his left in any order. Re-holster first pistol, draw second pistol and engage pistol targets again in any order. Second shooter picks up his shotgun from the saloon bar top and engages four swingers to his left any order. As soon as the second shooter is done, the first shooter picks up his shotgun staged in the jail rack and engage four swingers in any order. Stage is complete both shooters go to unloading table.

Note: Timer stays with first shooter.

Stage 1

Range A – Main Street

“Double Dewing Dudes”

Ammunition: 20 Pistol, 20 Rifle, 4 Shotgun

Pistols, loaded 5 each, holstered
Rifles, loaded 10 each, staged at Adobe Wall
Shotguns, loaded, 2 each, port arms, at Adobe Wall

You and your partner are standing at the Adobe Wall, watching the sun come up. What a beautiful morning, when you see a flock of quail. At the sound of the buzzer, the first shooter takes aim and shoots the popper, launching the first can. The second shooter takes out that can. The second shooter then shoots the second popper and the first shooter takes out the second can. Restage your O/E shotguns and pick up your rifles. The first shooter double taps R-1, the second shooter double taps R-1. Continue down the rifle targets double tapping each one until you reach R-5. Restage your O/E rifles at the Adobe Wall. Each shooter draws one pistol. The first shooter starts at P-1 sweeping to P-5. The second shooter starts at P-5 sweeping to P-1. Shooters alternate shooting. Re-holster your first pistol, drawing your second pistol. First shooter starts with P-5, second shooter with P-1. Shooters again alternate shooting. Re-holster pistol, stage is complete, go to the unloading table.

Procedural if you shoot out of sequence.

Times stays with first shooter.

Stage 6

Range D – Fort S. Roberts

“Don’t Mess With The Captain”

Ammunition: 10 Pistol, 20 Rifle, 4 Shotgun

Pistol, load 5 each, holstered.
Rifles, loaded 10 each, held at port arms.
Shotgun, O/E, Staged on Walkway, left and right.

While walking guard duty at Fort S. Roberts, because you angered with Captain Eli by asking to many questions, you are picked to walk the parapet until the sun rises in the west, that’s right the west. At the sound of the buzzer, the first shooter, sweeps the rifle targets in any order, until rifle is empty. Restage your O/E rifle, as the second shooters sweeps the rifle targets in any order, until rifle is empty. The first shooter draws his pistol and engages P-3 five (5) times. Re-holster that pistol, as the Second Shooters draws his first pistol and engages P-3 five (5) times. Re-holster that pistol. The Second shooters picks up his shotgun and engages any two shotgun swingers. The first shooter must engage two different swingers with his shotgun. Stage is complete, go to the unloading table.

Note: Timer will be with shooter number one as that shooter will fire the first and last shoots on this stage.
