

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

Pistol: 5

Rifle: 9

Shotgun: Some

Scenario: You are the sheriff of Fowler City. You have just returned to your office after a hard night in a running gun battle with the infamous Brown Brother gang. Some of them got away. It is mid-morning, and you just completed cleaning your irons. Shotgun and rifle are in the rack and the hog-leg is lying on the desk. You are about to reload your irons when a deputy runs in and hollers, “The Brown Boys are headed down the hill!”

Procedure: The shooter is standing in the sheriff’s office with ammunition staged on the platform in the corner. Rifle and shotgun are racked without ammo. Pistol is empty on the table. The Range Officer will say “the Brown Boys are headed down the hill” and then sound the buzzer. After the buzzer, the shooter grabs his rifle and begins loading and shooting at the 75-yard target up the hill. When 9 rounds are expended, the shooter goes for his pistol. Pick a target and empty your hog-leg then holster it. When the nine rifle and 5 pistol rounds are expended, the shooter grabs his shotgun and shoots at S1 and S2 the number of misses for rifle and pistol targets. When all misses are made up the stage is done.

SPECIAL ATTENTION: RO must get the number of misses from the counters in a timely manner so he can tell the shooter how many shotgun shells he needs to shoot. If the shotgun targets are missed, the shooter must make them up also.

SCORING: All rifle and pistol misses will count as 5 second penalties, but all hits with the rifle will count as 5 second bonuses.
